Alan Arthur Sundby, 69, Moffit, passed away March 20, 2013, at Sanford Health, Bismarck. A memorial service will be held at 11:30 am Monday, March 25, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck. Burial will be held at the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery, Mandan. There will be no visitation. Cremation has taken place. Alan was born January 5, 1944, in Washburn, ND, the son of LeRoy G. and Carol Brown Sundby. He was raised and educated in Turtle Lake, ND, and graduated from Turtle Lake High School. He attended college at UND, and moved to Fargo where he received his aircraft and power plant license. Alan served in the US military for two years. He married Sharon Edwards on February 17, 1968, in Moffit, ND. He was an iron worker for many years, retired and was then self-employed as a marine propeller rebuilder. He could fix anything but the crack of dawn. Alan is survived by his wife, Sharon, Moffit; his children, son Patrick Sundby and daughter Heather of Bismarck; his mother, Carol; sisters, Joanne Ronald Schlafman, Turtle Lake, Lori Allison, Minneapolis, MN; brothers, Dennis, Turtle Lake, and Mark Bonnie, Bismarck; many cousins and friends.
