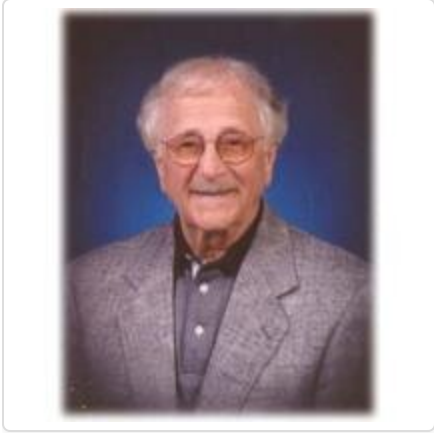




Albert Fetzer

February 13, 1928 - January 24, 2004

Albert W. Fetzer, 75, Bismarck, died January 24, 2004 at St. Alexius Medical Center. Services will be held at 10:30 AM Wednesday at Faith Lutheran Church, Bismarck, with the Rev. Wes Aardahl officiating. Burial will be at the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery with military rites by VFW Post 1326. Visitation will be from 11:00 AM to 9:00 PM Tuesday at Eastgate Funeral Service. There will be no visitation at the church. Albert W. Fetzer was born February 13, 1928 in Coleharbor, ND to Andrew and Katherine Schock Fetzer. He served in the United States Navy from 1946 to 1948. He married Ann Schon in Turtle Lake on November 19, 1950. They moved to Bismarck in 1951. In 1953 Albert founded Fetzer Electric and owned and operated the company for over 30 years. Albert is survived by his wife, Ann and their three daughters, Sheila Fracassi of Bismarck, Kim Clarence Kuntz of Mandan, and Lisa Loren Black of Mandan; seven grandchildren, Angela, Gina, and Michael Fracassi, Breanne and Andrew Renner, Katie and Karlee Black; and three step-grandchildren, John, Patrick, and Kelsey Kuntz. He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Ted. In lieu of flowers, the family prefers memorials to be given to Missouri Slope Lutheran Care Center or Anne Carlsen Center for Children.
