Albert Francis Wolf, 66, Mandan, died December 27, 2003, in a Mandan care center. Services will be held at 1:00 p.m. Wednesday at Boelter-Eastgate Funeral Service, 200 West Turnpike Avenue, Bismarck. Burial will be held at St. Mary's Cemetery, Bismarck. Visitation will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tuesday at Boelter-Eastgate Funeral Service and will continue from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday prior to the services at the funeral home. Albert was born March 20, 1937, in Linton, North Dakota, to Ignatius and Anna Wolf. He was raised and educated in Emmons County until moving to Bismarck as a high school freshman. He graduated from St. Mary's High School and then attended and graduated from Bismarck Junior College. He married Patricia A. Tomek in November of 1959 in Bismarck. Albert worked as a salesman most of his life, including an early career with North American Life and Casualty. He later worked as an account executive at KXMB TV in Bismarck and at KSJB radio in Jamestown, where he worked for many years. When Albert retired, he had started his own business, the AFW Company, which specialized in sales of marketing and promotional items. His favorite projects included providing items for Centennial celebrations in small towns in North Dakota and South Dakota. Albert's greatest passions were providing service to his customers and fishing on his boat named "Hard Luck". Albert was a gentle and caring man who will be deeply missed by his family and friends. He was very well known across North Dakota and South Dakota during his many years traveling for work. Albert is survived by his two sons

and one daughter-in-law, Bradford Wolf, Louisville, CO, and Brian and Kathy Wolf, Helena, MT; his five grandchildren, Jenna, Brandon, Dane, Brittany and Elizabeth; and his former wife, Patricia A. Ehlis, Bismarck. Albert is also survived by four sisters and three brothers, Milonia, Moorhead, MN, Christina, Dilworth, MN, Ottilia, Bismarck, Ann, Linton, ND, Mike, Bismarck, Pius, Merced, CA, and Aloys, Montebello, CA.
