Albinus "Beanie" Scherr, 77, Bismarck, went to be with his Heavenly Father on April 20, 2007, at St. Alexius Medical Center. Funeral services will be held at 11:30 AM on Tuesday, April 24, 2007, at Church of St. Mary in Bismarck with Rev. Bruce Krebs and Rev. Marvin Klemmer officiating. Burial will be at the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery. Visitation will be Monday from 9:00 AM - 9:00 PM at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, where a vigil service will be held at 7:00 PM, followed by a Knights of Columbus rosary service. Visitation will continue Tuesday one hour prior to the service at the church. Beanie was born on November 12, 1929, in Logan County, North Dakota, the son of Wendelin and Christina Weigel Scherr. He married Lillian Johs on October 17, 1951, at St. Philip Neri Catholic Church in Napoleon, North Dakota. He served during the Korean War as part of the 83rd Engineering Construction Battalion stationed in France, and was a member of the Amvets, American Legion, Knights of Columbus, and Moose Club. Beanie was founder of Scherr Plastering and owner and operator of Bismarck Lumber Company. He enjoyed spending time with his family and in his garden with Zoe.
