



## Alfred Huncovsky

May 8, 1915 - August 24, 2003

Alfred J. Huncovsky, 88, Bismarck, died August 24, 2003 in a local care center. Services will be held at 2:00 PM Thursday at Trinity Lutheran Church, Bismarck, with the Rev. Steve Sathre officiating. Burial will be in Sunset Memorial Gardens. Visitation will be from 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM Wednesday and 9:00 to 11:00 AM Thursday at Eastgate Funeral Service. Alfred was born May 8, 1915, at Dickinson, ND, the son of John and Caroline Suchy Huncovsky. He was raised and educated in Dickinson where he graduated from Dickinson High School in 1933. He began working as a messenger on a bicycle for Western Union in 1934. He then learned the Western Union operations and was sent to managerial school in Texas. He met his wife Dora Sorenson in Dickinson and they were married September 26, 1937. After operating Western Union offices in Dickinson, Mandan, and towns in Minnesota he was located in Bismarck where he remained until the office closed and he retired in 1971. After his retirement from Western Union Alfred worked for the Bismarck Parks & Recreation Department for 10 years. He was a member of the National Guard, Company K at Dickinson He enjoyed fishing, hunting, golfing, and following the San Francisco Giants. He and Dora spent many winters in the south and also visited other states and Hawaii. He and Dora celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary on a Caribbean Cruise in 1987 with Dora's niece, Jean and husband Les Hogan of Portland, OR, who were married on Dora and Al's wedding date. He was a longtime member of the Elks Club. Alfred is survived by his wife Dora, of Bismarck; one sister and

brother-in-law, Vi and Robert Curn, and one sister-in-law, Josephine Huncovsky all of Dickinson; and many loving nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and three brothers, Charles, William, and Donald.
