September 9, 1915 - January 14, 2009

Alice Cunningham, 93, lifelong Burleigh County resident, died January 14, 2009, at the Strasburg Care Center. Services will be held at 2:00 pm Monday at First Presbyterian Church, Bismarck, with Rev.
