Anne Werner, 89, Bismarck, died May 15, 2004, at St. Vincent's Care Center. Services will be held Friday, at 9:30 AM, at Church of Corpus Christi with the Rev. Paul Becker as the celebrant. Burial will be in St. Mary's Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 3:00 PM to 9:00 PM Wednesday, 9:00 AM to 2:30 PM and 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM Thursday at Eastgate Funeral Service, where a rosary and vigil will be held at 7:00 PM Thursday evening. There will be a visitation from 3:00 PM to 4:30 PM, Thursday, at St. Vincent's Care Center. Visitation will continue for one hour prior to the service at the church. Anne was born November 4, 1914 to Frank A. and Catharine Richter of Linton, ND. She was raised on a farm west of Linton and attended school in the area. She married John M. Werner August 11, 1933 in Bismarck. They lived in Linton until moving to Bismarck in 1935. In 1941, John and Anne, together, started and operated Werner's Standard Service until 1976. Anne was active in St. Mary's and Corpus Christi churches and was a member of Ministry of Praise. For many years she attended daily mass, until the winter of 2003. Anne had an especially deep love for her family. She enjoyed her yard work and growing her roses. She looked forward to her daily lunch visits with her friends at White Drug Cafeteria, calling them her Lunch Bunch Friends. Anne is survived by one son and daughter-in-law, George and Vernie Werner of Bismarck; two daughters and one son-in-law, Shirley Schneider of Bismarck, and Judy and Allen Felgate of Balsam Lake, WI; one sister, Tillie Schmidt of Hubertus, WI; eleven grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; and three great-great

grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband, John in 1983, one son, James in 1955, and two grandsons, Jonathon Werner and James Patrick Felgate, one son-in-law, Aloys Schneider, four brothers, Leo, Frank, Joe, and Alois, and one sister, Clara.
