Anton J. Doll, 88, Bismarck, died December 25, 2009, at the Baptist Home, Bismarck. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 am Wednesday, December 30, at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, Bismarck, with Rev. John Guthrie officiating. Burial will be held in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Bismarck, with full military honors. Visitation will be held from 2:00 pm until 9:00 pm Tuesday at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck, where a rosary will begin at 7:00 pm.
