Arnold Jacobson, 80, Napoleon, died February 18, 2007 at Wishek Nursing Home. Services will be held at 2:00 pm Friday at First United Methodist Church, Napoleon, with Rev. Grant Piehl officiating. Interment will be at the Dawson Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 10:00 am until time of service at the church. Arnold was born on April 14, 1926, to Joseph and Gunhild Rosell Jacobson at Crystal Springs, ND. They moved to Dawson, ND, approximately six years later. He lived Dawson until moving to Napoleon in 1972. Arnold worked for Northern Pacific Railroad which later became Burlington Northern Santa Fe for over 50 years until his retirement. Following his retirement, he was a very active member of the Napoleon Golden Age Club where he served a term as president and later continued to serve as a member of the board until entering the Wishek Nursing Home in December 2006. In his earlier years he enjoyed fishing, hunting, horses and visiting his family and friends. While Arnold was somewhat a private man, some would say he carried himself with dignity. While he didn't have much formal education, he had a wisdom and a sense of understanding that served him well. Arnold is survived by two sisters, Lillian Wanzek of Jamestown, ND, and MaryAnn Brunner of Napoleon, ND; three brothers, Marvin Lavonne Jacobson of Valley City, ND, Edwin Jacobson of Jamestown, ND, and Russell Kathy Jacobson of Kulm, ND; one sister-in-law, Yvonne Jacobson of Jacksonville, FL; and many nieces and nephews.
