Arthur Gene Lonnberg, 59, Bismarck, passed away on October 17th, 2010 at Medcenter One in Bismarck surrounded by family members. Services will be held at 11:30 am Friday, October 22, 2010, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, with Pastor Gary Heaton officiating. Burial will be in the North Dakota Veteran's Cemetery, Mandan. Visitation will be held from 5:00 pm until 8:00 pm Thursday at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, and will continue one hour prior to the service. Art was born in Jetmore, Kansas, son of Bill and Vivien Sinclair Lonnberg. He grew up in Holly, Colorado, and always expressed his pride in his hometown. He graduated in 1969 from Holly High School. He enlisted in the Army in 1970 and proudly served in Vietnam. After an honorable discharge in 1974, he began work in the oilfield industry for over 30 years. As an independent contractor for several companies, Art traveled around the country to sites in Kansas, Oklahoma, Texas, New York, Alaska, and other states. He married Judy Kaupp Lonnberg and together raised Jamon Lonnberg. Friends and family describe Art as a great storyteller, a man with an admirable sense of humor, and someone with a caring heart. Whether he was fishing with family and friends, telling stories around the dinner table, or working at his career, Art always had subtle ways of letting people know he cared deeply about them all. Art was a loyal member of the Fraternal Order of the Eagles and also a member of the Loyal Order of Moose. He found brotherhood in these organizations and enjoyed the company of his friends. Art is survived by his

son and daughter-in-law, Jamon and Natalie Kienzle Lonnberg of Jamestown, North Dakota; his brother and sister-in-law, Ted and Linda Lonnberg of Bristol, Colorado; nieces and nephews, and many good friends. He was preceded in death by his parents.
