



## Bernard Kirschmann

May 19, 1921 - September 19, 2012

Bernard Kirschmann, 91, Bismarck, crossed over after a brief stay at Elm Crest Manor in New Salem. A memorial service was held on October 6, 2012, at Parkway Funeral Service Chapel, Bismarck. He was buried the next day at Peace Lutheran Cemetery, outside of Regent. Bernard was born to the late Jacob Kirschmann and Margarethe Kaseman Kirschmann on May 19, 1921.
