



Clifford Bayer

November 5, 1919 - January 8, 2008

Clifford Bayer, 88, Tuttle, died January 8, 2008 at a Bismarck hospital. Services will be held at 11:00 am Saturday at the English Lutheran Church, Tuttle with Rev. Val Kinlan officiating. Burial will be in Tuttle Cemetery. Military rites provided by the Wing-Tuttle Color Guard and the ND National Guard. Visitation will be held from 2:00 pm until 9:00 pm Thursday at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck and from 1:00 pm until 9:00 pm Friday at Eastgate Steele Memorial Chapel, Steele, where a prayer service will begin at 7:30 pm. Visitation will continue one hour prior to services at the church. Clifford was born November 5, 1919, west of Tuttle, the son of William and Minerva Mullins Bayer. He grew-up and attended school in Tuttle, graduating in 1938. Following school he served in the C.C.C.'s From 1942-1945, he served in the US Army Air Corps in the European Theater. On June 19, 1948, he married Leora Hunter in Clam Falls, WI. They made their home in Tuttle, where Clifford farmed. Leora died on May 21, 1982. In 1986, he married Lorraine Blohm in Bismarck. Clifford enjoyed collecting, rocks, woodworking and reading. He loved spending time with his family. Clifford had a good sense of humor and was always ready with a one liner. He was a lifetime member of the VFW #6833, Tuttle, and served two terms as State VFW District 4 Commander. He was also an active member in the American Legion #65 Wing, and in English Lutheran Church and the Tuttle community. Clifford is survived by his son, Dean Loan Bayer of Tuttle, ND; his daughters, Kathy Wermager of Bismarck, ND and Mary Williams of Denver, CO; sister, Lois

Sedevie of Minot, ND; brothers, Bruce Bayer of Roberts, WI and Dale Bayer of Jamestown, ND; six grandchildren, Lynn Mark Heath, James J.J. Bayer, Trever Bayer, Jason and Shawn Wermager and Daniel Williams; five great-grandchildren, Zaine Wermager, Olivia, Owen and Landry Heath and Brody Bayer and ALLOTHER SPECIAL PEOPLE IN HIS LIFE.
