Corey Dean Eisenbraun, 58, Bismarck, passed away on July 10, 2013, at Sanford Medical Center in Bismarck. Service will be held on Monday, July 15, at 11:00 a.m. at Bethel Lutheran, Bismarck, with Rev. Tim Jenks officiating. Burial will follow at Sunset Memorial Garden, Bismarck. Visitation will be held on Sunday, July 14, from 5:00 - 9:00 p.m. at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, and will continue on Monday one hour prior to the service at the church. Corey was born on April 27, 1955, at Ellsworth Air Force Base, SD, to Wilhelm and Sylvia Schuler Eisenbraun. He spent time growing up in Wall, SD, but spent most of his life in Bismarck with his parents and siblings, where he graduated from Bismarck High School in 1973. On July 1, 1978, Corey married Carmen Dinkins in Dunn Center, ND, and they went on to make their home in Bismarck. Corey went to work for MDU at Heskett Power Plant and had spent the past 36 years working there. Corey and Carmen welcomed three wonderful children into this world during their 35 years of marriage: Roy born in 1979, Wyatt born in 1983, and Elon born in 1985. Corey spent much of his childhood doing the things he loved. He was an outdoorsman from the start, whether it was duck hunting, deer hunting, fishing, or camping with his family which he did quite often growing up and continued throughout his 35 years of marriage, passing that love on to his children. He also had a love for bowling which he had spent the last 20 plus years doing, and in recent years bowled alongside all three of his children and his two daughters-in-law.
