Dale Hackman, 42, Robinson, died October 28, 2003 at his home of a sudden heart attack. Services will be held at 10:30 AM Friday St. Paul's Catholic Church in Tappen with the Rev. Jerome Hunkler officiating. Burial will be at Fisher Cemetery, Tappen. Visitation will be held from 1:00 PM to 9:00 PM Thursday at Eastgate Steele Memorial Chapel, Steele and one hour prior to the service at the church. Dale was born May 7, 1961 at Trinity Hospital in Jamestown to Ralph and Alice Hills Hackman. He attended Tappen School and graduated from Tappen High School in 1979.
