Daniel G. Bauer Sr., 67, Selfridge, died May 4, 2013, in Selfridge, ND. Services will be held at 11:00 am Friday, May 10, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, with Pastor Phil Wolverton officiating. Burial will be in the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery, Mandan. Visitation will be held from 5:00 pm – 8:00 pm Thursday, May 9, at Parkway Funeral Service, Bismarck. Daniel was born July 2, 1945, in Bismarck, ND, the son of A.J. Bauer and Anna Marie Vogel Bauer. He grew up on the family farm 12 miles east of Center, ND. He attended Emanuel Grade School in Center. The family then moved to the Dr. Lipp farm east of Bismarck in 1962, where he graduated 8th grade from St. Anne's and attended Bismarck High School. Daniel joined the Army National Guard on February 16, 1963, he was stationed at Fort Leonard Wood Missouri, he was honorably discharged on January 8, 1971. Daniel lived and worked in Bismarck until he moved to Selfridge, ND, where he farmed and ranched until his death. His life was simple; he liked to go fishing, camping, and playing cards with family and friends, and making bets on who would catch the biggest fish. He also enjoyed helping friends and neighbors fix their equipment and having a good conversation while doing the job. Daniel is survived by one daughter, Kay Dave; one son, Danny; five grandchildren, Richard, David, Dwight, Tyrell, and Danielle; four brothers, Eddy Bea, Joe Dorothy, Robert Sue, and Calvin Nancy; two sisters, Isabelle and Linda John; special friends, Rose and Jeanette; and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by both

his parents; three brothers; and one sister.
