Darryl Red F. Lanz, 73, Glen Ullin, ND, died April 21, 2013, at Sanford Health, Bismarck, surrounded by his family after a short, courageous battle with cancer. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 am Friday, April 26, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Glen Ullin, with Rev. Jeff Zwack officiating. Burial will be in Glen Ullin Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 4:00 pm – 8:00 pm Thursday, April 25, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, where a vigil/rosary will begin at 7:00 pm.
