David L. O'Brien, 81, died May 7, 2004 in a local hospital. Services will be held at 1:00 PM Monday at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, Bismarck, with the Rev. Thomas Kramer officiating. Burial will be in St. Mary's Cemetery, Bismarck. Visitation will be from 2-9 PM Saturday and 1-5 PM Sunday at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck. Visitation will continue from 6-9 PM Sunday at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit where a Rosary will be held at 7 PM that evening. Visitation will also be held one hour prior to the service at the church. David was born October 13, 1922 at St. Paul, MN, the son of Leo and Frances Boht O'Brien. David loved the outdoors, hunting and fishing, photography, and history.
