Don Ensz, 65, died September 15, 2012, at Sanford Health after a short courageous battle of cancer with his family by his side. A memorial service will be held at 11:00 am Tuesday, September 18, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, with Ron Pister officiating.
