Doris B. Tessier, 92, Bismarck, N.D. passed away Thursday, May 28, 2009. A memorial service will be held at 1:00 pm Monday, June 1, 2009, at St. Vincent's Care Center Chapel, Bismarck, with Rev. Paul Becker officiating. Burial will be held in the North Dakota Veteran's Cemetery, Mandan, N.D. Doris was born March 24, 1917, in Woonsocket, RI, the daughter of Louis and Dora Provost Leveille. She was raised and educated in Woonsocket, RI. Doris was very proud of her time spent working in the yarn mills as a spinner; it was there she met her future husband Arthur. Doris married Arthur A.J. Tessier on September 22, 1945, in Woonsocket, RI. They lived in Forestdale, RI. where she enjoyed years of service with the VFW Auxiliary, knitting, crocheting, ceramics, reading, and playing cards. In 1980, Doris and A.J. retired to Winter Haven, FL. In April 2004, she moved to Bismarck to be near her family. Doris is survived by her daughter-in-law, Sandra Tessier, Bismarck, ND; her granddaughter, Tammy Tessier-Kealy and her husband, Jim, and her great-granddaughter, Grace, Bloomington, MN. She was preceded in death by her husband, Arthur A.J.; her son, Richard; and her parents. While A.J.'s remains have been interred at the National Veteran's Cemetery in Florida, he and Doris will now be interred together at the North Dakota Veteran's Cemetery, Mandan, N.D.
