Eda C. Werner, 89, Bismarck, died February 27, 2005, at a Mandan care center. Funeral services will be Thursday at 11:00 AM at Faith Lutheran Church in Bismarck with the Rev. Joel Sherer officiating. Burial will be Thursday at 2:30 PM at Woodlawn Cemetery in Steele. Visitation will be Tuesday from 12:00 - 9:00 PM and Wednesday from 9:00 - 11:00 AM at Eastgate Funeral Service in Bismarck, Wednesday from 1:00 - 3:30 PM at Eastgate Steele Chapel, Wednesday from 5:00 - 9:00 PM at Eastgate Funeral Service in Bismarck, and Thursday one hour prior to the service at the church. Eda was born on November 16, 1915, in Evergreen Township near Frazee, Minnesota, the daughter of Reinhard and Hulda Schwarzrock Janke. Bill died on February 9, 1986 in Bismarck. Eda was a member of Faith Lutheran Church, Friendship Circle, Mary Martha Circle, 50 Club, and Swing Band. She enjoyed bowling, sewing, reading, and playing cards. Eda was dearly loved and will be deeply missed by her family and many good friends. She is survived by one son and two daughters-in-law, Duane "Swede" and Diane Werner of Bismarck, and Darlene Skare and her husband, Ralph of Britton, South Dakota; eight grandchildren; fifteen great-grandchildren; many great-great-

grandchildren; one brother, Martin Janke of Steele; and several nieces and nephews.
