Edwin Renz, 79, Bismarck died December 25, 2007 at St. Vincent's Care Center. Services will be held at 11:00 am Saturday at Church of St. Mary in Bismarck with Charlie Heidt officiating. Graveside services will be held at 1:00 PM on Saturday at Moffit Cemetery. In later years, he worked for several Moffit area farms. Although a quiet man, Eddie had a quick wit and a dry sense of humor. He also enjoyed playing the accordion.
