December 10, 1916 - January 28, 2007

Ernest Albrecht, 90, Steele, died January 28, 2007, at a Steele care center. Funeral services will be Wednesday at 2:00 pm at Golden Manor Chapel in Steele with Rev. Paul Tjostem officiating. Burial will be at Glueckstal Cemetery. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service at Golden Manor. Ernest was born on December 10, 1916, south of Tappen, North Dakota, in Peace Township, the son of George and Rosina Dockter Albrecht. He attended school in Peace Township and after school, he worked as a farm and railroad laborer. Ernest served in the U.S. Army from 1942 - 1945 and was stationed in the Philippines. Following the war, he took over the family farm with his brother, Arthur. Ernest is survived by his brother and sister-in-law, Edward and Katherine Albrecht of Steele; his sister-in-law, Alice Albrecht of Underwood; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents; his brothers, John, Christopher, Fred, and Arthur; and his nephew, DuWayne Albrecht.
