Ervin L. Specht, 82, Bismarck, passed away on October 30, 2012, at St. Alexis Medical Center. Funeral services will be held on Friday at 2:00 PM at Our Savior's Evangelical Lutheran Church in Bismarck with Pastor Jordan Ertl officiating. Burial will be at Sunset Memorial Gardens.
