Frank Neigum, 80, Bismarck, died July 9, 2009, at his home surrounded by his family. Mass of Christian burial will be held at 12:00 Noon Monday at Church of the Ascension with Rev. Marvin Klemmer officiating. Burial will be held in St. Mary's Cemetery, Bismarck. Visitation will be held from 2:00 pm until 5:00 pm Saturday and from 1:00 pm until 8:00 pm Sunday at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, with a prayer service beginning at 4:30 pm Sunday at the funeral home. Visitation will continue Monday one hour prior to the service at the church. Frank was born August 19, 1928, in Linton, ND, the son of Alexander and Catherine Feist Neigum. He grew-up and attended school in St. Michael's area east of Linton. During the 1950s, Frank worked for Apple Creek Country Club. He married Leota Waddell at the Church of St. Mary in Bismarck on June 22, 1959; two weeks ago, Frank and Leota celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary. Frank worked for the City of Bismarck Water Treatment Plant, retiring in July 1990. Frank enjoyed taking care of his large garden and tending to his yard. He also enjoyed family get-togethers "in the nest", camping, playing pinochle, and spending time with his grandkids.
