Fred Jaeger, 82, Mesa, AZ, formerly of Bismarck, died December 6, 2003 at his home in Mesa. Services will be held at 11:00 AM Monday at Faith Lutheran Church, Bismarck, with the Rev. Wes Aardahl officiating. Burial will be in Sunset Memorial Gardens. There will be no visitation. Fred was born March 24, 1921 in rural Zap, ND, to Fred and Anna Masmundt Jaeger. He attended schools in Zap. He served in the US Army from 1944 - 1946, where he was a rifle sharpshooter and truck driver. Following his discharge he worked for Bismarck Grocery. In 1947, Fred married Elsie Teske in Beulah, ND. He then worked at the Post Office in Bismarck. They moved to Arizona in 1969 where he also worked at the Post Office. He retired in 1983. He looked forward to returning to North Dakota to go fishing. He enjoyed golfing, dancing, caring for his yard and needlepoint. Fred is survived by one sister Anne Mathias and numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his wife, his parents, five brothers, and three sisters.
