



## Fred Werner

July 15, 1916 - March 16, 2010

Fred Werner, 93, Bismarck, died March 16, 2010, at Missouri Slope Lutheran Care Center. Services will be held at 10:30 am Friday at the Bismarck Seventh Day Adventist Church, with Pastor Dennis Miller officiating. Burial will be held in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Bismarck. Visitation will be held from 12 Noon until 9:00 pm Thursday at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck, and will continue one hour prior to the service at the church. Fred was born July 15, 1916, on a farm near McClusky, ND, the son of John and Lydia Oswald Werner. He left North Dakota and went to California in search of work. Fred returned home to ND in 1937 to farm. He again ventured out to California and worked for Douglas Ducraft for 3 1/2 years. Fred married Christine Zuern on May 16, 1942, in Los Angeles, CA. In 1943, they moved to the DH Wall farm south of Denhoff, ND. Later, they purchased the farm and lived there until 1983, when they retired. Starting in 1988, Fred and Christine worked for ten years at Hillside Motel Rentals. In 1998, Fred worked as the custodian at Ruth Meier's Hospitality House. He is survived by his daughter and son-in-law, JoAnn and Bob Arnold; one sister, Ellen Walz, Phoenix, AZ; two granddaughters, Angie Salvatore, Boynton Beach, FL, and Denise Arnold, Deltona, FL; three great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews. Fred was preceded in death by his wife, Christine; his parents; ten brothers; and two sisters.
