Frieda Heihn, 92, Bismarck, died June 15, 2009, at the Mandan Living Center. Services will be held at 2:00 pm Friday at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, with Rev. Steve Sathre officiating. Burial will be held in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Bismarck. Visitation will be held one hour prior to the service at Parkway Funeral Service.
