Garry Budeau, 66, Bismarck, died June 6, 2012, at Missouri Slope Lutheran Care Center, Bismarck. Burial will be in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Bismarck. Visitation will be held from 2:00 – 7:00 pm Sunday, June 10, at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck, where a prayer service will begin at 7:00 pm.
