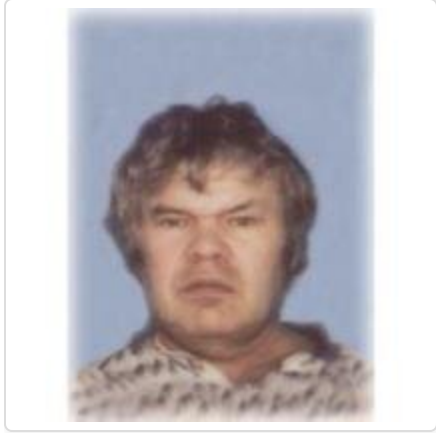




Gary Schmidt

Gary Lee Schmidt, 53, Bismarck, passed away on April 5, 2007. Funeral services will be Tuesday at 1:00 PM at Zion Lutheran Church in Bismarck with Rev. Thomas R. Marcis, Jr. officiating.
