Gideon Frey, 88, Bismarck, died September 9, 2003 in a local care center. Services will be held at 10:30 AM Saturday at the Baptist Home Chapel, Bismarck, with the Dr. Willis Potratz and Chaplain Clyde Leimberer officiating. Burial will be in the Ashley City Cemetery. Visitation will be from noon to 9:00 PM Friday at Eastgate Funeral Service and one hour prior to the service at the Baptist Home.
