Glenn Stanley Faust, 77, Bismarck, died December 7, 2003, at 4:15 AM after a long illness. Funeral services will be Thursday at 1:00 PM at Amelia Bailey Methodist Church in Moffit. Visitation will be Wednesday from 5 - 9 PM at Boelter-Eastgate Funeral Service, 200 W. Turnpike Ave., Bismarck, where a prayer service will be held at 7:00 PM. Glenn was born on December 8, 1925, in Moffit, North Dakota, the son of H. Albert and Selma Martha Steiner Faust. He attended schools in the Moffit area graduating in 1944. He was drafted in 1950 and served in the tank corps armored division in Korea and received the Bronze Star. He returned to Moffit where he farmed for many years before selling the farm due to health reasons. Glenn continued working in the area for many years. He married Merle Cochran in November 1, 1980. He had many interests including horses, cattle, and "cowboying". He was an avid reader and enjoyed lively discussions about politics and religion. Some of his hobbies included family and community history, leatherworking and saddle work. Following a bout of stomach cancer, Glenn moved to Bismarck where he lived at the time of his death. He is survived by his sisters, Fern Nieland of Wapato, Washington, Doris Rash of Bismarck, Ina Oppegard of Dazey, North Dakota, and Alice Gene O'Connell of Cooperstown, North Dakota; his step-children, Meredith Peterson, Nels Peterson, and Melody Weber; and his nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, great-great-nieces, great-great-nephews, and many close friends. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife Merle; his sister, Ruth; his brothers, Melvin and Lloyd; and
