Glenn R. Schmidt, 61, Bismarck, passed away on June 17, 2011, at a Bismarck hospital. Funeral services will be held on Thursday at 11:00 AM at Zion Lutheran Church in Bismarck with Rev. Thomas R. Marcis, Jr. officiating. Burial will be at St. Concordia Cemetery in Beulah, ND. Visitation will be Wednesday from 3:00 - 8:00 PM at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, where a prayer service will be held at 7:00 PM.
