Grace A. Dahl, 89, died February 14, 2006 at a local care center. Services will be held at 11 AM Monday at First Lutheran Church, Mandan, with the Rev. Larry Giese officiating. Burial will be at the Parkin Lutheran Cemetery, Fort Rice. Visitation will be held from 5-7 PM Saturday at Eastgate Funeral Service. A family prayer service will be held from 1-2 PM Sunday at Eastgate Funeral Service. Visitation will continue from 2-9 PM at the funeral home and one hour prior to the service at the church. Grace was born October 22, 1916, in McLaughlin, SD, to Edgar and Mabel Clapp Belden. She graduated from High School in 1933 from Flasher. She also attended Beauty School in Minneapolis, MN. She participated in homemakers, was a 4-H leader and participated in the silver haired legislator. She loved to dance, play cards and was a member of the kitchen band as a stumper fiddler. Grace loved to sing and play piano. She liked all kinds of crafts including crocheting but her greatest accomplishment was her painting starting at age 58 winning many awards.
