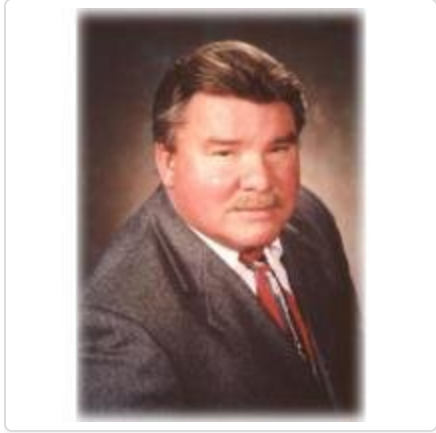




Gregory Ekblad
