



Henry Dosch

May 2, 1929 - April 30, 2005

Henry Dosch, 75, Bismarck, died April 30, 2005, at his home. Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, May 4, at 12:00 Noon at Church of St. Anne in Bismarck with the Rev. Ed Wehner officiating. Burial will be at St. Mary's Cemetery. Visitation will be Tuesday from 12:00 - 9:00 PM at Eastgate Funeral Service where a vigil service will be held at 6:30 PM. Visitation will continue Wednesday one hour prior to the service at the church. Henry was born on May 2, 1929, in Strasburg, North Dakota, the son of Rochus and Teckla Roehrich Dosch. He was raised and attended school in Strasburg. Henry entered the United States Army in 1951. Henry married Christina Wald on June 4, 1953, in Strasburg. They made their home in the Strasburg area and farmed for seven years. They then moved into Strasburg where Henry operated the Cream Station. He was a butcher for Wagner's Produce and Meat Market and later managed Schneider's Bar. He and Christina then moved to Bismarck where Henry worked for Lunn Construction as a bricklayer. In 1965, he moved his family to Ypsilanti, Michigan, for one year to work at the Ford manufacturing plant. After returning to Bismarck, he was a bricklayer for Burns Masonry for five years. He then managed Our Place Tavern for about five years. Henry then owned and operated Interstate Texaco and U-Haul for eight years. He then went to work for NC Rolfson Construction Company as a backhoe operator for eight years. He retired from Ayrcom Contractors Company as a backhoe operator in 1998. Henry enjoyed hunting, fishing, and bowling. He loved baseball and he played with an amateur team

in Strasburg. He also enjoyed playing pinochle up until his last days. He had a passion for gardening and was known for his pickled fish and his horseradish. Henry and his wife, Christina, enjoyed many good years of dancing together.
