Henry Link, 92, Bismarck, died January 12, 2004, at his home. Funeral services will be held at 1:00 PM on Thursday at Faith Lutheran Church in Bismarck with the Rev. Wes Aardahl officiating. Burial will be at ND Veteran's Cemetery. Visitation will be Wednesday from 2 PM - 9 PM at Boelter-Eastgate Funeral Service, 200 W. Turnpike Ave., Bismarck, and will continue Thursday one hour prior to the service at the church. Henry was born on June 13, 1911, in Golden Valley, North Dakota, the son of Karl and Katherine Horning Link. The family moved to the Stanton area in 1916. He married Lillian Krecklau in Stanton on October 17, 1937. Following their marriage, they lived in Hazen where Henry worked for the city drayline. In March of 1944, he entered the U.S. Army during World War II where he served in Europe until January of 1946 when he was honorably discharged. Henry and Lillian moved to Hazen in 1946 where he worked for Peavey Lumber and Arrow Creamery. They moved to Bismarck in 1958 where Henry worked for Western Steel and Plumbing until his retirement. He leaves his wife of sixty-six years, Lillian of Bismarck; four grandsons, Rick and Michelle, Mike, Terry and Tammy, and Dan and Deedra; one granddaughter, Wendy and Robert Fontenot, all of Bismarck; twelve great-grandchildren, Justin, Jason, Jennifer, Michael J., Nathan, Austin, Kaitlyn, Courtney, Mason, Spencer, Libby, and Abby; his daughter-in-law, Loretta Link of Bismarck; three sisters, Ida Buxbaum of Crown Point, Indiana, Emma and Frank Burrell of Portal, Indiana, and Frieda Sczcur of Garrison; and one sister-in-law, Minnie Link of Medina.
