Herbert J. Rodenbough, 92, Bismarck, died on Sunday, April 4, 2004. Funeral services will be Thursday at 11:00 AM at Boelter-Eastgate Funeral Service Chapel, 200 W. Turnpike Ave., Bismarck, with the Rev. James Moos and Rev. Chuck Loftis officiating. Burial will be at Mandan Union Cemetery. Visitation will be Wednesday from 12:00 PM - 9:00 PM at Boelter-Eastgate Funeral Service. Herbert was born on July 13, 1911, to James and Grace Lake Rodenbough at Wakpala, South Dakota. They moved to Shields, North Dakota, in 1913 where Herb attended grade school. He graduated from high school in Ellendale, North Dakota. In 1935, Herb married Agnes Disrud in Flasher, North Dakota. Herb was a business owner in Shields until 1949. He owned and operated Olson and Rodenbough Construction Company in Dickinson for many years. Later he was manager of Flasher Lumber Yard until his retirement. Herb was a loving family man and appreciated his many friends. His life and faith were richer for always having a church family. A highlight of that was the United Church of Christ 6:30 AM Bible study. He was an avid sports fan. He played ball in his youth and never lost interest. Herb was an active lifetime member of the United Church of Christ. He was a 71-year member of the Flasher Masonic Lodge and also a 50-year member of Scottish Rite and the Shrine. Herb is survived by his wife, Agnes of Bismarck; his daughter and son-in-law, Jan and Dennis Stanford of Rapid City, South Dakota; his grandson, Michael Stanford of Rapid City; his brother-in-law, Al Disrud and his wife, Ruth; and his sister-in-law, Helen Disrud.
