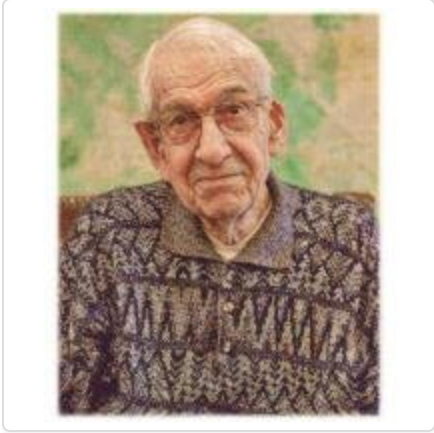




Jack E. Easton

March 26, 1921 - October 3, 2013

Jack E. Easton, 92, Bismarck, died October 3, 2013, at a Mandan hospital. A memorial service will be held on Tuesday at 10:30 AM at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bismarck with Rev. Steve Sathre officiating. Burial will be at 1:00 PM at the ND Veterans Cemetery. Jack was born on March 26, 1921, in Warren, MN, the son of Chauncey and Alice Everts Easton. He was raised and attended school in Cokato, MN, and graduated in 1939. He then attended St. Cloud State University and received his master's degree at Moorhead State University graduating Magna Cum Laude. Jack was enlisted in the US Army from 1942 – 1945 during World War II and was honorably discharged. Jack taught high school in Bismarck. He married JoAnn Hedner on June 7, 1958, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Bismarck. After their marriage, they lived in Fargo, Jamestown, and then Bismarck, where Jack worked as a counselor at Heartview. Jack was very proud of being an Eagle Scout in high school. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church. Jack is survived by his wife, JoAnn of Bismarck; his sons, Blake Jolene Easton of Fergus Falls, MN, and Bruce Easton; seven grandchildren; one nephew; and nieces. He was preceded in death by his parents; one sister, Tori; and one niece.
