



## Jacob Braun

April 8, 1907 - April 6, 2006

Jacob Braun, 98, died April 6, 2006 in a Napoleon Care Center. Services will be held Monday at 2 PM at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit with the Rev. Thomas E. Kramer officiating. Burial will be in St. Mary's Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 2-9 PM Sunday at Eastgate Funeral Service where a rosary will be held at 7 PM Sunday. Jacob was born April 8, 1907 in a sod house 17 miles Southwest of Napoleon, ND the son of Franz and Marcelene Goetz Braun. Jacob entered the United States Army on March 29, 1942 and was discharged in April of 1945 and returned to North Dakota. He married Beata Landies on October 14, 1946. Jacob worked at the Patterson Hotel for about 6 months and then went into the building trade as a carpenter. In later life, he was the custodian for the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit and the Cathedral School. He was a member of the Eagles, the KC's, the VFW, the DAV, and the American Legion. He was also a member of the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, Bismarck. Jacob is survived by his brother, Clemens Marion Braun, Grand Coulee, WA; and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his wife; his parents; six brothers, Joe, Martin, Wendlin, Sebastian, George, and Tony; three sisters, Eva, Theresa, and Magdalen; and one infant sister.
