Jacob Carl Meyer, 84, Bismarck, left this world to be with his Heavenly Father on February 27, 2010. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday at 2:00 PM at the Baptist Home in Bismarck with Rev. Wes Aardahl and Rev. Chris Alexander officiating. Spring burial will be held at Baldwin Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Monday from 2:00 – 8:00 PM at Eastgate Funeral Service and will continue on Tuesday one hour prior to the service at the Baptist Home. Jacob was born on February 2, 1926, on the family farm near Baldwin, ND, the son of Julius and Sophie Karch Meyer. Jack, as he was better known as, attended school at Croft School through the 8th grade. He served in the US Army for a short period of time. Jack handed this tradition down to his son and grandchildren. After retiring, Jack and Anne moved into Bismarck and most recently, were residents of the Baptist Home. You could be sure there was a bag of candy hidden somewhere close by. Jack was a past member of the Elks and the Eagles. He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Anne of Bismarck; his daughter-in-law, Mary Ann Mike Meyer of Bismarck; his grandchildren, James and Jenn of Baldwin and Paul and Tonya of Bismarck; his great-grandchildren, Jonathan and Hannah of Bismarck; and his brothers, Billy of
