May 23, 1916 - July 20, 2009

Jake Redinger, 93, Bismarck, died July 20, 2009, at a local nursing home. A graveside service will be held next week, Saturday, August 1, 2009, at Tappen City Cemetery. There will be no visitation as cremation has taken place. Jacob "Jake" Redinger was born May 23, 1916, at Crystal Springs, ND, the son of Jacob and Christina Zimbelman Redinger. He was raised and educated at Crystal Springs and farmed with his family and other families for many years. He joined the US Army serving on ground duty on the California coast area with the 140th Infantry and for another two years as part of the 41st Division Company A in the Asiatic Pacific in New Guinea, the Biak Island, The Philippines, and part of the first occupation forces in Japan. Jake married Tillie Lang in Steele, ND, on October 21, 1951. In 1955, they moved to Park City, MT. Tillie died on October 15, 1986. Jake married Leah Fifer on March 3, 1987, in Florida. They lived in Park City and Bismarck. Leah passed away on April 11, 2004. Jake moved into Valley View Heights earlier this year and recently into Missouri Slope Lutheran Care Center. He is survived by a number of nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his wives, Tillie and Leah; his parents; and four brothers and one sister.
