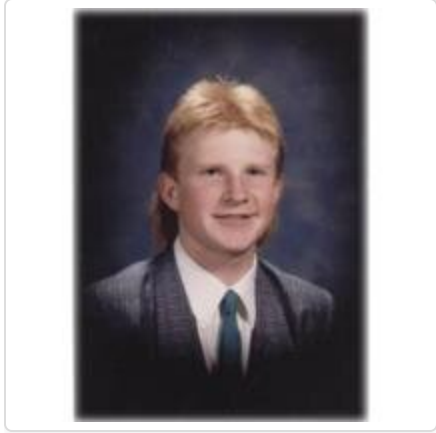




Jason Scherr

Jason Scherr, 34, formerly of Bismarck, passed away on September 15, 2006, at the home of a very special couple in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.
