Jeffrey Hoang Klop, 33, Bismarck, died at home after a courageous battle with liver cancer on November 30, 2014. Services will be held at 10:00 am Friday, December 5, 2014, at Church of Corpus Christi, 1919 N 2nd Street, Bismarck, with Rev. Paul Becker officiating. Burial will be held at St. Mary's Cemetery, Bismarck. Visitation will be held from 5:00 pm – 9:00 pm Thursday, December 4, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck, where a rosary/vigil will begin at 7:00 pm. Jeffrey was born July 9, 1981, in Kalamazoo, Michigan, to James and Lan Klop; he attended Parchment High School and graduated from Michigan State University in May of 2004 with a Bachelor's of Science and Central Michigan University in May of 2009 with a Master's of Science in Administration. On June 6, 2009, he married Krissondra Wolf Klop in Bismarck, ND. After graduating from Michigan State University, he worked for GlaxoSmithKline as an executive pharmaceutical sales representative and lived in Bay City, Michigan, where he met Krissondra. They established their first home in Traverse City, Michigan in 2008, and he continued to work for GlaxoSmithKline as a vaccine sales representative. Upon moving to Bismarck, he was employed by Sanford Health as a clinic manager. Jeff's children were his greatest pride and joy. We will all remember him as a very accomplished man as a father, husband, son, brother, and friend. He was known for his loyal friendship, witty personality, and ability to create nicknames for everyone upon first meeting them. His outgoing personality immediately made new acquaintances feel like an old friend. He was an active
