John Clement, 81, Bismarck, died June 6, 2009, at St. Alexius Medical Center in Bismarck. A memorial service will be held on Monday, June 8, 2009, at 1:30 PM at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck. There will be no visitation as cremation has taken place. Interment will be held at the North Dakota Veteran's Cemetery with a reception immediately following at Parkway Funeral Service.
