Joseph Seifert, 79, Bismarck, died May 17, 2005, at his home after a courageous battle with cancer. Services will be held at 10:30 AM Friday, May 20th, at the Church of the Ascension, Bismarck, with the Rev. Marvin Klemmer officiating. Burial will be at the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery, Mandan. There will be no visitation. Joseph was born February 10, 1926, the son of Phillip and Belgum Schaefer Seifert in Haynes, ND. Joseph was raised and educated on a farm north of Haynes. He joined the United States Army on June 29, 1951 and served in the Korean War. Joseph was honorably discharged on March 30, 1953. After being honorably discharged, Joseph married Dorothy Rose Mosbrucker on September 7, 1953 in Center, ND. Joseph was employed with Skeel's Electric as an Electrician retiring in 1988. He was a member of the Church of St. Anne, the Eagles, the AmVets, the American Legion, the Moose and the IBEW Local 714.
