Joyce Barbie, 87, Bismarck, died Saturday, June 2, 2012, in her home. A memorial service will be held at 1:00 pm Saturday, June 9, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck. There will be no visitation as cremation has taken place. Joyce Marjory Stoen was born in Bismarck on July 23, 1924, to Oliver and Florence Henry Stoen. She was raised and educated in Bismarck, graduating high school in 1942. She married Nicky Barbie on September 28, 1943. Together they raised three children and built a cabin on Lake Isabel where Joyce loved to spend time with her sisters, children, and grandchildren. In addition to raising her family, Joyce worked first as a dental assistant and later as a secretary at Grimsrud Elementary School. She worked in the office at Grimsrud from 1961 until her retirement in 1985. She received an award from the school for her excellent service. Joyce is survived by her children, Richard, Jody and Steve Barbie; her granddaughters, Jillian Hagen and Meagan Barbie; great-granddaughter, Sydney Hagen; and her sisters, Alice Rudrud and Barbara Abfalter. She was preceded in death by her husband, Nicky.
