Katherine Bosch, 84, Bismarck, died March 19, 2015, at Missouri Slope Lutheran Care Center in Bismarck.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Monday at 12:30 PM at Cathedral of the Holy Spirit in Bismarck with Rev. Msgr. Thomas Richter officiating. Burial will be at the ND Veterans Cemetery on Monday at 3:00 PM.

Visitation will be held on Sunday from 3:00 – 9:00 PM at Eastgate Funeral Service in Bismarck where a rosary/vigil service will be held at 7:00 PM. Visitation will continue on Monday one hour prior to the service at the church.
