Kenneth Ulmer, 56, Bismarck, died June 18, 2007, at a Bismarck hospital. Services will be held at 11:00 AM Friday at First United Methodist Church, 924 N 11th Street, Bismarck, with Rev. Darrel Aleson officiating. Burial will be in the North Dakota Veterans Cemetery, Mandan, at 11:00 AM on Monday. Visitation will be held from 9:00 AM until 9:00 PM Thursday at Eastgate Funeral Service, Bismarck, and continue one hour prior to services at the church. Ken was born on November 1, 1950, in Bismarck, ND, the son of Robert B. and Lydia Magstadt Ulmer. He was raised and attended schools in Bismarck where he graduated from BHS in 1968. He then went on to graduate from BJC. Ken enlisted in the National Guard and upon his return from California he married Marguerite Weigum on November 28, 1970, in Bismarck. They made their home in Bismarck. Ken worked as an accountant for Midwest Motor Express, Cofell's Plumbing and Heating, Fort Abraham Lincoln Foundation, and for the past 14 years at the Convention and Visitors Bureau. Ken enjoyed camping and hunting over the years, going after birds to big game; and he especially loved the badlands. He was a past member of the Amvets, American Legion, and the Elks.
