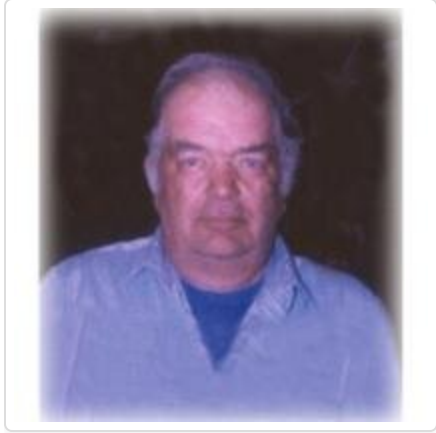




Larry Shimek
