Laurie Tanner, 61, Mandan, died peacefully at CHI St. Alexius Hospital February 21, 2015, after a battle with cancer. A memorial service will be held at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, February 25, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck. There will be no visitation as cremation has taken place. Laurie was born May 9, 1953, in Minot, ND, the daughter of Ernest and Greta Knutson. Laurie was raised on the family farm in Kongsberg and attended a one-room school house through the 8th grade.
